At Marlbrook your child is using a programme called Lexia Reading Core 5 which the children use on our school laptops. This programme helps the children with their reading and spelling skills. They love playing the educational games and we have also seen a real improvement in their reading and spelling ability from using this programme.

We now have home access to this so your child can complete tasks at home. We would ask if you could encourage your child to use this programme from home if you have the ability to access it. Please also remember our E-Safety rules where children are using devices – they should only access it in 20-30 minute sessions.


Your child can use Lexia through the internet by going to the following website:

You will see the screen below – please input the email sjenkins@marlbrook.hereford.sch.uk



You will then see the screen below – your child then needs to use the login they use for school. So for example, for a child called Tom Smith their login would be: tsmith and their password would be pupil.





Once completed they will see the following screen and they can start their Lexia fun!



You can also, if you wish, download the Lexia App on iPad or Android tablets by searching for 'Lexia Reading Core5 UK'. Please note this app is not available for Kindle devices.
